Auto Burglaries

Our Auto Burglary rate still remains high. Central Station Officers have made 75 arrests year to date and work every day to capture suspects. Our next strategy is to meet with as many rental car agencies as possible to develop and implement prevention plans. In addition to the work developed by Central Station's Community Police Advisory Board with the creation of "Park Smart" informational cards, I will be proposing that a 8.5"x 11" laminated placard be placed in the passenger side window of the vehicle when parked stating "No valuables in this vehicle." It will serve as a reminder to the tourists who rent cars to remove their valuables as well. I am always interested in ideas from the community.

Speaking of auto burglary prevention, when I was leaving work last night, I was in the station's secure underground parking. I noticed a family placing items in their car while inside our garage. **Officer Joseph Marte** approached me and explained that he was handling a call for service at Hyde and Bay. Unrelated to the call, he met a couple from Utah with their three children who said that they were going to Alcatraz and were wondering where to park. **Officer Marte** realized there were valuables in their car and suggested the family could leave their property in our garage, enjoy the Alcatraz tour and return to our secure police garage to pick up the items. This is an example of what Central Station Officers do above and beyond to make our community safe. As I mentioned to **Officer Marte** as I left the garage, "one less auto burglary report today."

On July 8th, two Hispanic male suspects rang the bell of a resident on the 1200 block of Union Street claiming to be with the Water Department. The victim, who was elderly, let the suspects in her home. They told her that they needed to check for possible sewage problems. They walked around all of her rooms and when they did not find anything, they said she needed to pay them \$100 for their service. The victim told the suspects that she had no money and so they left. Please be careful for these scams and mention this to elderly relatives and friends. Do not let anyone in your home and always verify identity by making a phone call. If the situation appears suspicious, you can always call us and we will make sure the visit is legitimate.

Crimes of Note

Definitions

Robbery – Robbery is the taking of property from another by using force or by using fear.

Assault – An assault is an unlawful attempt, coupled with the present ability, to commit a violent injury on another person.

Battery - (Misdemeanor battery) is any willful and unlawful touching of another.

(Felony battery) is the use of force or violence upon the person of another that causes serious bodily injury.

***Assault is when a person swings their arm and battery is when that arm makes contact with another person.**

Aggravated Assault – Assault upon another person with a deadly weapon or instrument other than a firearm or by any means of force likely to produce great bodily injury.

Burglary – The intent upon entry into a property to commit grand theft, petty theft, or any felony.

Grant Theft – Grand theft is theft committed when the value of the money, labor, or property taken exceeds \$950.

Petty Theft – Theft where the value of the property taken is less than \$950.

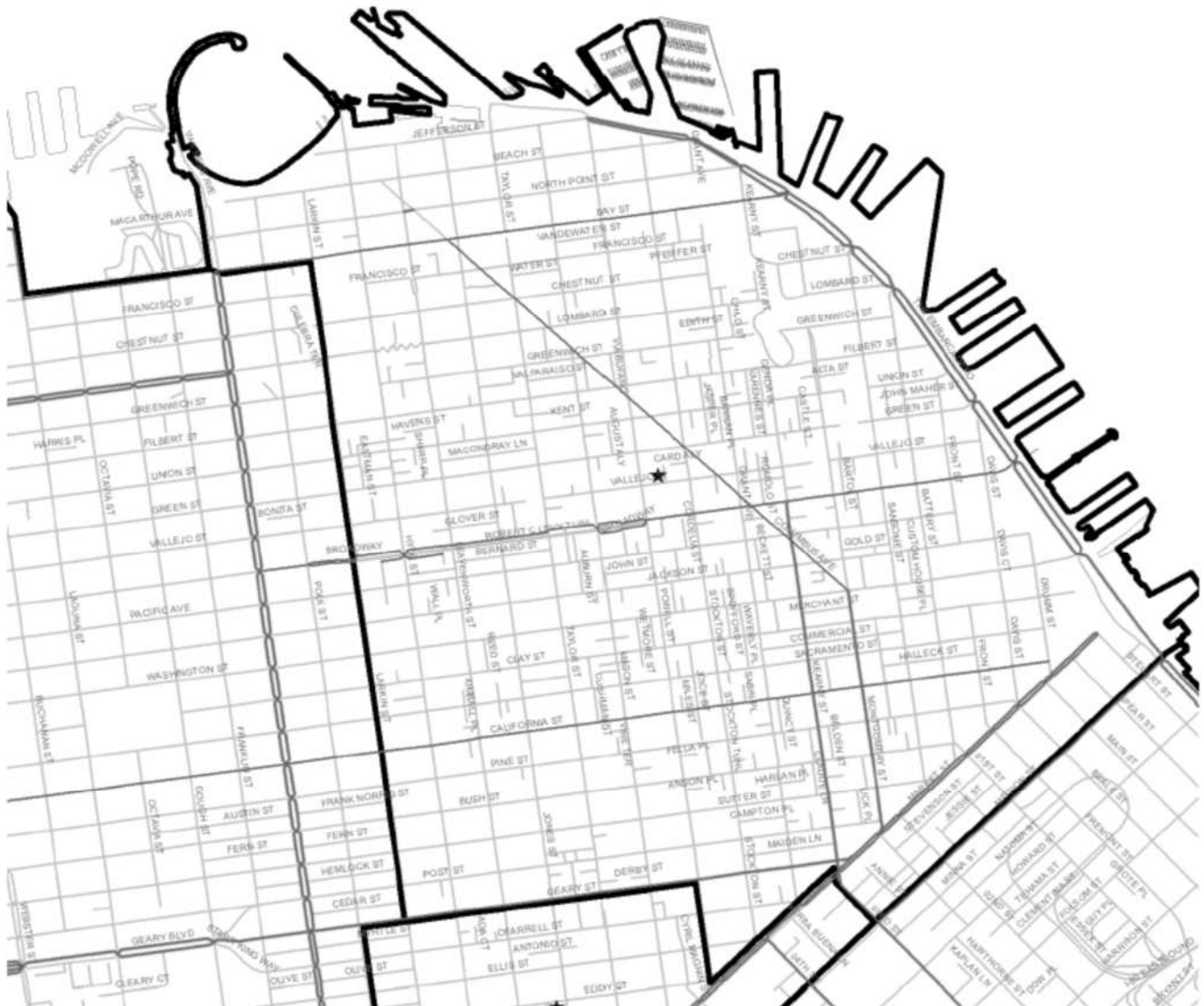
